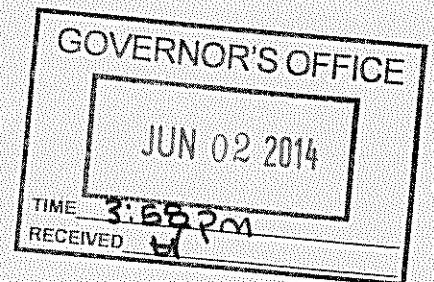

AN ACT

To enact R.S. 13:312.5, relative to courts and judicial procedure; to provide relative to courts of appeal; to provide relative to the Fourth Circuit Court of Appeal; to provide relative to certain fees; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 13:312.5 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§312.5. Fourth Circuit Court of Appeal; fees

The Fourth Circuit Court of Appeal may charge a filing fee not to exceed fifty dollars for a civil motion not otherwise subject to any other fee. The fee amounts collected shall be used to defray operational and maintenance expenses of the court.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
