O R D E R

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution, article V, section 1, and the inherent power of this Court, and considering the emergency created by the potential for hazardous weather and conditions associated with Hurricane Zeta,

IT IS ORDERED that the Court of Appeal, Fourth Circuit shall be closed on Wednesday, October 28, 2020.
