O R D E R

Acting in accordance with Louisiana Constitution, article V, section 1, and the inherent power of this court, and considering the necessity to heretofore modify court operations due to the pandemic created by COVID-19 (Coronavirus), and

Further considering the current existing mitigation measures, subject to current social distancing guidelines and the use of face coverings:

IT IS ORDERED by the Court that all oral arguments will be held in the courtroom of the Court of Appeal, Fourth Circuit effective May 3, 2021;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk's Office of the Court will be accessible to members of the public for filing purposes only effective May 3, 2021;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the convenience fee associated with the use of the Court's electronic filing system will resume at a cost of \$50.00 per transaction effective May 3, 2021;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that mailing of all notices by the Court shall be sent only by electronic means to counsel of record and via United States mail to pro se or self-represented litigants;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT this Order supersedes the Court's Order of June 23, 2020.
